Paddy and Scott,

This is the regulatory authority regarding the FWAB:

6 AAC 25.670. Federal write-in ballot

(a) For a statewide primary, general, or special election, a qualified voter who has properly applied under AS 15.20.081 <http://www.legis.state.ak.us/basis/folioproxy.asp?url=http://wwwjnu01.legis.state.ak.us/cgi-bin/folioisa.dll/stattx09/query=%5bJUMP:'AS1520081'%5d/doc/%7b@1%7d?firsthit> for an absentee ballot and has not received the ballot may vote for all federal and state candidate races, each judicial retention election, and ballot proposition or question scheduled to appear on the ballot that the voter is eligible to participate by using a federal write-in absentee ballot. The voter must be

(1) an absent uniformed services voter; or

(2) voting by absentee ballot from outside the United States.

(b) In completing the federal write-in ballot, the voter may designate a candidate for each candidate race for a primary election by writing in the name of the office and candidate or, for the general or special election by writing in the name of the office and candidate or by writing in the office and the name of a political party. If the voter has written in the name of the political party, for a general or special election the ballot will be counted for the candidate of that political party certified to appear on the state's official ballot. Any abbreviation, misspelling, or other minor variation in the form of the name of a candidate or political party will be disregarded in determining the validity of the ballot, if the intention of the voter can be ascertained. For judicial retention elections the voter may designate the voter's vote by writing the name of the judge and writing "yes" to retain a judge or "no" to not retain a judge. For ballot propositions or questions the voter may designate the voter's vote in writing the ballot proposition or question assigned number and writing "yes" to enact the proposition or question or "no" to not enact the proposition or question. The voter shall sign and shall have the voter's ballot witnessed in the manner prescribed under AS 15.20.081

This is the statutory provision regarding the 60-day special advance ballot.

I have attached four sample special advance ballots, one for each judicial district, for the upcoming general election. There are also four other special advance ballots for the upcoming general election without the race for State Senate, as not all State Senate races are up for election. I have also attached the instructions that are sent with special advance ballots and the candidate list for the Republican Party ballot (there is also a candidate list for the other ballot) Alaska that was sent with the primary special advance ballots.

Sec. 15.20.082. Absentee voting by mail from outside the United States or in a remote area; special absentee ballots.

(a) The director shall prepare special absentee ballots under this section for use in a state primary election, a state general election, and a state special election when the voter notifies the director in writing that the voter expects to be living, working, or traveling outside the United States at the time of the election, or in a remote area of the state where distance, terrain, or other natural conditions deny the voter reasonable access to a polling place at the time of the election. The director shall prepare the ballot so that it may be sent to the absentee voter 60 days before the date of the election. The director shall list on the ballot the different races to be voted on at the particular election on a statewide basis, and, if the director prepares the ballot without the names of candidates printed on the ballot, the director shall provide the voter with information described in (c) of this section.

(b) A special state absentee ballot prepared for use under (a) of this section shall contain each judicial retention election and ballot proposition or question scheduled to appear on the particular ballot.

(c) A special state absentee ballot prepared for the state general election or for a state special election shall, if the names of candidates are not yet certified, permit a voter to cast a ballot for all the candidates of a particular political party that expects to have candidates appear on the ballot; for this purpose, the director shall prepare the ballot with party boxes and a blank line for each office to be voted on in that election. The voter may vote for a candidate for that office by writing in the name of a person and filling in the oval to the right of that name, or the voter may mark one of the party boxes. If the voter puts a mark in a party box for that office, the director shall count the mark as a vote cast for the candidate for that office nominated by that party. If the voter writes in a name for an office, the vote shall be counted as a write-in vote for that office. The director shall count the ballots under AS 15.15.360 <http://www.legis.state.ak.us/basis/folioiproxy.asp?url=http://www.jnu01.legis.state.ak.us/cgi-bin/folioisa.dll/stattx09/query=%5bJUMP:'AS1515360'%5d/doc/%7b@1%7d?firsthit>. The director shall provide the voter with the names of each candidate appearing on the primary election ballot and the names of any candidates who have qualified by petition to appear on the general election ballot.

(d) The director shall prepare the regular absentee ballots as soon as is reasonably possible and shall send the regular absentee ballot to each person receiving a special absentee ballot under this section. The director

shall, if the regular absentee ballot is received within the time required by law, count the regular absentee ballot in preference to the special absentee ballot.

6 AAC 25.660. Special advance ballot.

(a) Under AS 15.20.082

The voter may give written notice by

(1) including a statement, on the application for a by-mail ballot, that the voter expects to be outside the United States or in a remote area of the state at the time of the election;

(2) checking or otherwise marking the box provided for that purpose on the state application for a by-mail ballot;

(3) affixing the sticker provided for that purpose by the United States Department of Defense to the application for a by-mail ballot; or

(4) providing an overseas address in the space designated on an absentee by-mail application for ballot mailing address.

(b) A special advance ballot will be mailed to a voter who provides written notice under (a) of this section if the application is received not later than 28 days before the election in which the voter seeks to vote.

(c) A voter voting a special advance ballot shall mail the ballot to the director who shall maintain a record of each ballot received as prescribed under AS 15.20.081

(d) A voter receiving the special advance ballot will also be sent the official ballot as soon as it is available. On or after the 15th day following the election, the director, in the presence and with the

assistance of the state review board, will determine if the regular ballot sent to the voter under AS 15.20.082





3. Sign Your Ballot Envelope & Provide ONE Identifier

In the presence of your witness, sign your ballot envelope and provide at least ONE Identifier on the back of the return mailing envelope.

VOTER CERTIFICATE and IDENTIFICATION

By law your ballot cannot be counted unless you include your signature, have it witnessed and provide an identifier. I declare that I am a citizen of the United States and that I have been a resident of Alaska for at least 30 days. 
