Re: MOVE ACT HARDSHIP WAIVER APPLICATION

Dear Director Carey:

This supplements our July 27, 2010, correspondence regarding our waiver application.

The Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) can be filled out by three categories of voters: (1) member of the uniformed services or merchant marine on active duty, or an eligible spouse or dependant, (2) a U.S. citizen residing outside the U.S. temporarily, and (3) a U.S. citizen residing outside the U.S. indefinitely. The first two categories receive a standard ballot containing all appropriate federal, state, and county contests. The third category receives a ballot with only federal contests. As we understood your focus to be on the mailing out of our standard ballots, we provided you information regarding FPCA requests in categories 1 and 2. To the extent you are interested in all three categories we are providing you the following updated information:

County of Hawaii

The County of Hawaii has received a total of 7 FPCA requests in categories 1 and 2. The delivery preference indicated on the FPCAs is as follows: Mail 3, E-mail 2, Fax 0, and No Preference Indicated 2. There were no FPCA requests in category 3.

County of Maui

The County of Maui has received a total of 2 FPCA requests in categories 1 and 2. The delivery preference indicated on the FPCAs is as follows: Mail 1, E-mail 1, Fax 0, and No Preference Indicated 0. There was 1 additional FPCA request in category 3. The delivery preference was by e-mail.

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City and County of Honolulu

The City and County of Honolulu has informed us that it has received 54 FPCA requests in categories 1 and 2. The delivery preference indicated on the FPCAs is as follows: Mail 42, Email 12, Fax 0, and No Preference Indicated 0. Additionally, there are 30 FPCA requests in category 3. Those requests indicate a delivery preference as follows: Mail 23, E-mail 7, Fax 0, and No Preference Indicated 0.

County of Kauai

The County of Kauai has received a total of 2 FPCA requests in categories 1 and 2. The delivery preference was email for one and the other was left blank. There were no FPCA requests in category 3.
