

Instructions – Post Election Report Form – New York

FVAP is seeking specific information on three kinds of results of voters’ ballots, each with multiple ways of being returned to an election office.

The three kinds of results for UOCAVA voters’ ballots are those where the voter’s ballot was:

- **returned** in time to be counted;
- **not returned** in time to be counted; or
- **rejected** for reasons other than late receipt.

For each of these three results, FVAP is interested in knowing how the ballot was returned to the election office. The five categories of possible return are: postal mail, facsimile, email, online receipt and other.

Definitions:

<p>Received in time to be counted</p>	<p>Ballot was received by the local election official in time to be included in the final tabulated vote totals for the State. Ballots that are timely received, but for some other reason are not able to be included in the State’s final vote totals should be counted as received timely.</p> <p>Differentiate between 1) final official absentee ballots sent by the election jurisdiction, 2) “federal only” ballots or State Write-in Absentee Ballots (SWABs) or other ballots also or alternatively sent by the election jurisdiction to UOCAVA voters, and 3) Federal Write-In Absentee Ballots (FWABs).</p>
<p>Received too late to be counted</p>	<p>Ballot was received by the local election official, but arrived after the cut-off time and was not included in the final vote totals for the State. It would be helpful, but is not required, if a jurisdiction can indicate how many ballots in this category were received within a week after the deadline, and how many were received later than that.</p>
<p>Rejected for reasons other than late receipt</p>	<p>Ballot was cast, but not counted, by the local election official for reasons other than not being received by the election jurisdiction in time.</p> <p>Differentiate between different reasons for rejection, and specifically identify how many FWABs/SWABs/other ballots were rejected due to the timely receipt of the final official absentee ballot.</p>
<p>Postal Mail</p>	<p>All ballots received from the US Postal Service or other commercial delivery carriers, including those providing regular and express delivery.</p> <p>Differentiate between expedited delivery mail, whether by USPS</p>

	or another commercial delivery carrier, and non-expedited delivery postal mail.
Facsimile	All ballots received by facsimile.
Email	All ballots received by email.
Online Receipt	All ballots received through any online voted ballot system or other online transmission service that is not email.
Other	All ballots received by some other means than postal mail, facsimile, email, or online receipt, as described above. This includes, but is not limited to hand-delivery by the voter or designated POA, proxy vote, or some other mean not included in the categories above.

In the Post Election Report Form table enter numbers into the corresponding boxes. Given that a voter may return more than one ballot, your total # of ballots received may be less than the totals in each of the sub-groups.
