Subject: Follow-up Actions Related to the Approval of the State of Rhode Island's MOVE Act Waiver Request under Section 102 (g)(2) of UOCAVA for the November 2, 2010 Federal General Election

On August 27, 2010, the State of Rhode Island's application for a MOVE Act waiver request under Section 102 (g)(2) of the UOCAVA for the November 2, 2010 Federal General Election was approved.

The waiver approval laid out a number of reporting requirements for Rhode Island. The table below provides additional guidance on meeting those requirements.

(Date: September 20, 2010); Certify to the Presidential Designee that all jurisdictions in Rhode Island have posted the State absentee ballot on Rhode Island's Voter Information Center website no later than September 24, 2010. (Date: September 25, 2010); Certify to the Presidential Designee that all jurisdictions in Rhode Island transmitted official final State absentee ballots to UOCAVA voters no later than October 3, 2010. (Date: October 4, 2010); Report to the Presidential Designee following the close of the election the following information: Ballots transmitted (with sub-points for APO/FPO, US street, overseas civilian); Ballots received in time to be counted (with sub-point for APO/FPO, non-US street). (Date: 90 days after final certification of the general election results)
