As of October 1, 2010, Washington had 48,789 registered UOCAVA voters. The total number of ballots issued, 53,074, exceeds the number of registered UOCAVA voters because many voters who were sent a ballot by email or online delivery were also sent a ballot by postal mail.

Washington does not track UOCAVA voters for only this election, but on an ongoing basis as part of voter registration. Consequently, Washington does not categorize UOCAVA voters based on their transient location of (1) military overseas, (2) military domestic, or (3) overseas civilian. Rather, Washington categorizes voters as simply military or overseas civilian. Consequently, the additional category of "ballots sent to an unknown military status or location" was added to the FVAP chart to capture all data.

The information provided on this form is certified by the Secretary of State, State of Washington to be true and representative of the total number ballots and method of ballot delivery that were provided to UOCAVA voters by October 1, 2010.
