## Texas Runoff Election on May 27

---

The State of Texas will hold its primary runoff election on May 27. If you are a Texas resident living outside your voting jurisdiction and wish to vote in the primary runoff and you did not request a ballot for the Texas primary, you must register on or before April 28. You may register to vote absentee using the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) at [FVAP.gov](http://FVAP.gov). If you complete and return this form, Texas will register you as an absentee voter and send you your ballot for any elections this year.

If you are already registered in Texas and you did not request an absentee ballot for the primary, you must request your primary runoff ballot by May 20. You may request a ballot by using the FPCA.
