## Virginia Primary Election on June 10

---

The State of Virginia will hold its primary election on June 10. If you are a Virginia resident and want to vote in the primary, you must be registered by May 19. If you live outside your election jurisdiction and need to register to vote absentee, you can do so using the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) available at [www.FVAP.gov](http://www.FVAP.gov). If you complete and return this form, Virginia will register you as an absentee voter and send you your ballot for all elections this year.

If you are already registered in Virginia, you must request your ballot by June 3 if you want to vote in the primary.
