## Michigan Primary Election on August 5

---

Michigan will hold its primary election on August 5. If you are a Michigan resident and need to vote absentee, you may register and request an absentee ballot using the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) found at [FVAP.gov](http://FVAP.gov).

Complete, sign and send the FPCA to your local election official. Forms need to be received by July 7.
