Arizona Primary on August 26, 2014

Arizona will hold its Primary on August 26, 2014. If you are an Arizona resident and need to vote absentee, you may register and request an absentee ballot using the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) found at FVAP.gov.

Complete, sign and send the FPCA to your local election official. This form needs to be received by 7pm August 26, 2014.
