

# HOW TO VOTE FROM ANYWHERE IN 2 Simple Steps... WHEN YOU'RE A MILITARY SPOUSE

## HERE'S HOW:

STEP

1

**FILL OUT THE *FEDERAL POST CARD APPLICATION (FPCA)* AT [FVAP.GOV](https://fvap.gov) TO REGISTER AND REQUEST YOUR BALLOT**

Send it to your election office by **August 1\***  
(or later depending on your state) for the  
General Election on November 3, 2020.

2

**FILL OUT AND SEND IN YOUR BALLOT  
WHEN IT ARRIVES**

### WHEN?

By your recommended deadline:



**October 13, 2020**  
*outside the U.S.*



**October 27, 2020**  
*stateside*

**WHAT IF THE BALLOT DOESN'T ARRIVE  
IN TIME TO FILL OUT AND SEND BACK  
BY THE DEADLINE?**

Use the *Federal Write-In Absentee  
Ballot (FWAB)* as a backup ballot  
at [FVAP.gov](https://fvap.gov).
