### Instructions

This outreach toolkit can support your organization in its efforts to maximize the importance of voter registration as part of Overseas Citizens Voters Week (June 28 - July 4, 2024) and Independence Day activities.

Available content includes:

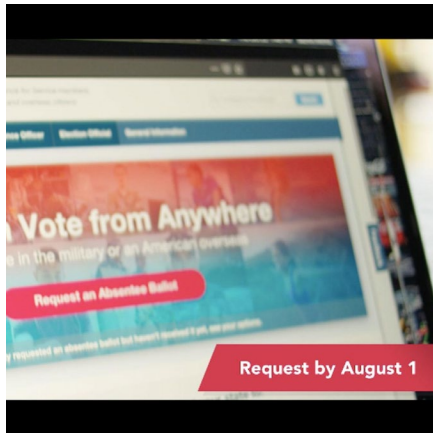

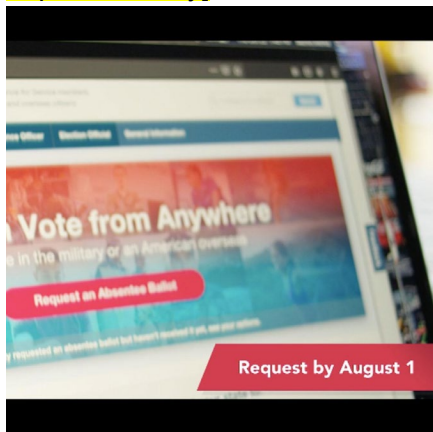

# HOW TO VOTE FROM ANYWHERE IN 2 Simple Steps... WHEN YOU'RE A MILITARY SPOUSE

MILITARY LIFE CAN TAKE YOU LOTS OF PLACES.  
**YOU CAN VOTE FROM ALL OF THEM.**

If you or your spouse is living away from your voting residence,  
your military family can still vote absentee.

## HERE'S HOW:

STEP  
**1**

FILL OUT THE **FEDERAL POST CARD APPLICATION (FPCA)** AT **FVAP.GOV** TO REGISTER AND REQUEST YOUR BALLOT

Send it to your election office by **August 1\***  
(or later depending on your state) for the  
General Election on November 5, 2024.

### WHEN?

By your recommended deadline:



**October 13, 2024**  
outside the U.S.



**October 27, 2024**  
stateside

WHAT IF THE BALLOT DOESN'T ARRIVE  
IN TIME TO FILL OUT AND SEND BACK  
BY THE DEADLINE?

Use the *Federal Write-In Absentee  
Ballot (FWAB)* as a backup ballot
