- The 2024 United States elections are scheduled to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. During this presidential election year, the President and Vice President will be elected.
- Start planning your voter training sessions: Start now so that you can assist voters from states with early primary elections.
- Plan to participate in one of the training workshops conducted by the FVAP in or near your
 area beginning in the new year 2024. All Voting Assistance Officers are required to attend a
 workshop or complete online Voting Assistance Officer Training at
 https://www.fvap.gov/vao/training.
